Another friendly reminder that we are a SunSmart school and hats are a must throughout Terms 1 and 4 each year.




SCHOOL PHOTOS


OCTOPUS SCHOOL

SCHOOL SPORTS FIELD - AN UPDATE

There has been lots and lots of progress with our sports field over the past two and a half weeks. All contaminated soil has been removed and the landscapers are currently replanting garden beds, reinstalling the goalposts and installing an irrigation system.

The field will be covered with a geo-fabric and 300mm of topsoil will then cover this. Grass seed will then be laid and the completed field will be handed over to the school for the beginning of the 2021 school year.
